+ **THANKSGIVING FOR BAPTISM**

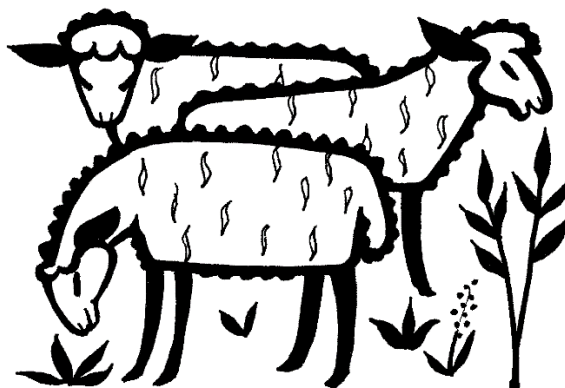
In the name of the Father, and of the † Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**

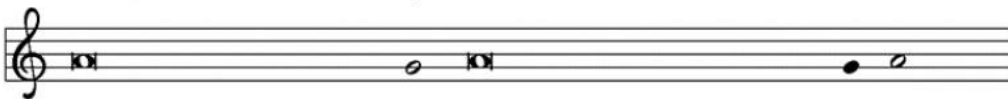

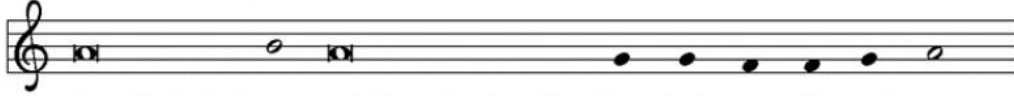

FIRST READING - Acts 4:5-12

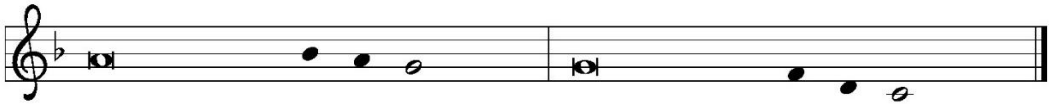




